Police Officer Jason Chambers

WHEREAS, Police Officer Jason Chambers DSN 6795 has been chosen as 2008 Police Officer of the Year for the First Police District; and

WHEREAS, throughout the term of his distinguished career, Officer Chambers served as a Police Recruit in Training from April 2005 until his promotion to Probationary Patrol Officer in November 2005 while being assigned to District Eight where he was promoted to Police Officer in April 2007. Officer Chambers has served in the First District since October 2007; and

WHEREAS, prior to his time as an Officer for the St Louis Metropolitan Police Department, Officer Chambers graduated from Hazelwood West High School after earning all conference and state awards for swimming, he also excelled in football. Jason later joined the armed forces as a member of the US Marine Corps. Upon completing his tour of duty from the US Marine Corps, Officer Chambers continued his education at Webster University, until he was accepted as a recruit for the St Louis Metropolitan Police Department in April 2005; and

WHEREAS, Officer Chambers was twice named Officer of the Month in 2008 and once in 2007, and has received numerous Department Awards of Excellence during his four year career, also receiving two “Chief’s Letter of Commendation” in 2008; and

WHEREAS, Officer Chambers family members, his parents, Denise & Gordon Chambers and brother, Jimmy, can share in the awarding of Officer Chambers as Officer of the Year, and be proud of this award and look forward to his continued success as a Police Officer for the St Louis Metropolitan Police Department.
