
About the data:

The P.L. 94-171 summaries (released by US Census Bureau, February 24, 2011) have population totals and summaries by race, Hispanic or Latino, and voting age for all appropriate geographic areas: state, counties or equivalent areas, state legislative districts, voting districts, county subdivisions, school districts, places, American Indian/Alaska Native/Native Hawaiian areas, census tracts, block groups, and blocks.

New for the 2010 Census, housing unit counts will be included as part of the 2010 Census Redistricting Data [P.L. 94-171] Summary Files. Also for 2010, states recommended including school districts as part of the geographic summary levels and a new table on housing unit occupancy status. More data will be released beginning in the summer/fall 2011.

All data aggregated from Census blocks.

Census blocks—smallest of census geographic areas, normally bounded by streets or other prominent physical features or by the boundaries of geographic areas. They may be as small as a typical city block that's bounded by four streets/alleys. Blocks are identified by a four-digit number, unique within census tracts for the 2010 Census. Nationally, blocks average about 100 people each.




