The City of St. Louis, Board of Public Service, will be requesting bids for a Roof Replacement on the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Academy building, 315 S. Tucker Blvd., St. Louis, MO. The roofing system will be a Thermoplastic Polyolefin (TPO) roofing system with a 20 year guarantee. The roof area is roughly 8,500 S.F.

All work under this contract will be paid for in cash, based on monthly estimates of the work completed, less a retained amount of ten (10%) percent. Final payment, including all retained percentages, will be made within ten (10) days after completion of all work and final acceptance by the City.

LIVING WAGE REQUIREMENTS

Bidders [Proponents] are hereby advised that the St. Louis Living Wage Ordinance #65597 and associated Regulations apply to the service [concession] [lease] [City Financial Assistance] for which [bids] [proposals] are being sought herein.
