

1           AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO PARKING WITHIN “THE  
2           OLIVE/PINE RESIDENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT”; AUTHORIZING  
3           THE TRAFFIC ADMINISTRATOR TO DESIGNATE THE LOCATION  
4           AND RESTRICTIONS FOR CURB PARKING OF RESIDENTIAL  
5           PARKING ZONES WITHIN THE RESIDENTIAL PARKING  
6           DISTRICT; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF RESIDENTIAL  
7           PERMIT PARKING ONLY PERMITS WITHIN THE DISTRICT BY  
8           THE TRAFFIC ADMINISTRATOR; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF A  
9           PRIVATE ENTITY TO ADMINISTER THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS;  
10          PROHIBITING THE PARKING, WITHIN THE DISTRICT, OF ANY  
11          VEHICLE WHICH DOES NOT DISPLAY THE AUTHORIZED  
12          PERMIT; CONTAINING DEFINITIONS, EXEMPTIONS, A PENALTY  
13          CLAUSE AND AN EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

14        **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

15           **SECTION ONE. Definitions.**

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17           A.        “The Olive/Pine Residential Parking District” is the area beginning at the west  
18           curb line of 17<sup>th</sup> Street at the intersection of 17<sup>th</sup> Street and Olive; thence south along the west  
19           curb line of 17<sup>th</sup> Street to Pine; thence west along the north curb line of Pine Street to the  
20           intersection with 18<sup>th</sup> Street, thence south to the south curb line of Pine Street to the 17<sup>th</sup>  
21           Street, thence continuing north to the middle of Pine Street, thence east along the middle of  
22           Pine to the intersection with vacated 16<sup>th</sup> Street; thence north along the west curb line of  
23           vacated 16<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with Olive, thence West on the north curb line of Olive  
24           to the intersection with 17<sup>th</sup> Street.

26           B.        “Parking Permit” is a valid resident or parking permit issued for The  
27           Olive/Pine Residential Parking District by the Supervisor of Parking.

29           C.        “Resident” is a person who lives in property abutting a street designated in  
30           whole or in part as a residential parking zone.

1 D. "Residential Parking Zone" is any street, or any portion of a street, within the  
2 boundaries of The Olive/Pine Residential Parking District which is designed and posted by the  
3 Traffic Administrator as a Residential Parking Zone with specific parking restrictions.

5 **SECTION TWO. Designation of Residential Parking Zones.** The Traffic  
6 Administrator is hereby authorized to designate the location and restrictions for curb parking  
7 of Residential Parking Zones on any street or portion of any street within The Olive/Pine  
8 Residential Parking District upon the completion of a traffic survey which documents that  
9 thirty-three percent (33%) or more of the parked vehicles on a given block within The  
10 Olive/Pine Residential Parking District are not owned by the residents, and when the  
11 Alderman from the Ward, wherein the street is located, recommends the designation.

12 **SECTION THREE. Permit Issuance.** The Traffic Administrator may issue annual  
13 parking permits to the residents of The Olive/Pine Residential Parking District. The Traffic  
14 Administrator may contract with a Missouri nonprofit corporation or other entity, at no cost to  
15 the City, for the procurement, assignment, and distribution of such annual parking permits,  
16 and the procurement and installation of necessary signage. Based on regulations approved by  
17 the Traffic Administrator, Residents may apply for temporary permits to allow their invitees  
18 to park in the Residential Parking Zone.

19 **SECTION FOUR. Permit Use.** When signs are erected upon streets in The  
20 Olive/Pine Residential Parking Zones designating "Residential Permit Parking Only" during  
21 certain hours of the day on certain days, no person, firm or corporation shall park or cause to  
22 be parked any vehicle during any time that does not display a Resident Parking Permit;  
23 provided, however, that public parking shall not be prohibited from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.  
24 Monday through Friday.

1           **SECTION FIVE. Disabled Parking.** The provisions of this ordinance shall not  
2 supersede or diminish the authority of the Traffic Administrator, upon the recommendation of  
3 the Commissioner for the Disabled, to issue, under the provisions of Ordinance 65142, a  
4 residential disabled parking permit for any parking space within The Olive/Pine Residential  
5 Parking District. The holder of a residential disabled parking permit shall be exempt from the  
6 provisions of this ordinance.

7           **SECTION SIX. Penalty for Violation.** Any person, firm or corporation who shall  
8 park or cause to be parked any vehicle in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall  
9 upon the conviction thereof be fined twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each such offense.

10           **SECTION SEVEN. Emergency Clause.** This being an ordinance for the  
11 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency  
12 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of  
13 St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by  
14 the Mayor.

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
