## Taxpayers to Receive Property Tax Bills Beginning November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Due December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012

**St. Louis, MO, November 8, 2012** – On Saturday, November 10<sup>th</sup>, City of St. Louis property owners will begin receiving their annual personal property and real-estate tax statements from the City's office of the Collector of Revenue. These bills are payable by or before December 31<sup>st</sup> as designated by Missouri State Statute.

The office will issue in excess of 220,000 notices this year calculated at a tax rate of \$7.4974 per \$100 of assessed valuation compared to last year's rate of 7.2070 as set by the taxing authorities.

2012 property bills may be paid in several ways: by calling 1-800-2PAYTAX as noted on the bill itself; using our online payment system, [www.officialpayments.com](http://www.officialpayments.com); via mail using the enclosed return envelope; in person in Room 109 of City Hall from 8am – 5pm Monday thru Friday or by visiting one of our four satellite bank locations. The satellite banks are as follows: Bank of America; 4301 Hampton Ave., Bank of America; 9075 Goodfellow Blvd., M&I Bank; 2301 South Kingshighway Blvd., or PNC Bank; 4131 South Grand Blvd. during normal banking hours. Customers may direct any questions regarding the collection or payment of their bills to our Property Tax Department at (314) 622-4106 and are encouraged to pay their bill in a timely manner. Payments not received on or before the December 31<sup>st</sup> deadline will be subject to penalties and interest beginning January 1, 2013 as required by law.

Please note that our satellite bank locations may hold holiday hours on December 24<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>; we will honor these hours where applicable. All bills postmarked on the 31<sup>st</sup> are received on time.
